Supply List

Book:

- 3rd Edition Start Quilting
by Alex Anderson

Thread:

- 50 wt. cotton thread to blend with fabrics
 - Please have a bobbin wound with the same thread prior to class.

Fabrics:

- This medallion sampler is designed with the intent of a strong contrast between background and coordinating fabrics that will require about 4 yards of fabrics. (See the attached Fabrics Cheatsheet for details on fabrics needed for piecing,)
- Borders, sashing, binding, backing and batting fabrics for sampler lap/wall quilt to be determined in class.



You will need your sewing machine in every class:

- A straight stitch presser foot and needle plate
- Stitch in the Ditch presser foot
- Optional: Quarter-inch presser foot with edge guide
- 80/12 sewing machine needles
- Extra bobbins

Tools:

- 3" x 18" and at least an 6.5 x 12-inch ruler, Quilter's Select recommended
- 6.5-inch square ruler by Bloc-loc
- Ultimate Flying Geese Tool by Creative Grids
- Rotary cutter, and self-healing mat
- Fineline chalk fabric markers
- Seam ripper
- Travel iron and pressing mat
- Stiletto, glass head pins (heat proof) and scissors
- Pencil or pen and paper to take notes
- Walking foot for machine quilting
- Masking tape or a pad of stick post-it notes

All supplies must be purchased at Linda Z's.
A discount is given for class supply purchases

Quilting TWO Fabric cheatsheet

Note: This medallion sampler quilt is designed with a strong contrast between the background fabric and the various coordinating fabrics. So, if you wish to have a dark background fabric, choose light coordinating fabrics. If you wish to have a light background, choose medium to dark coordinating fabrics.

Fabric A: 2 yards
(Background fabric)



Coordinating Fabrics B:

2 yards consisting of 8 to 10 half- & quarter-yard cuts. If using fat quarters, plan on needing multiples of a couple of the fabrics.

Binding / Backing / Batting

Binding = 2.5" wide X length of finished pieced top's 4 sides
(to be determined in class)

Backing = Width of finished pieced top + 8" X Length of pieced top + 8 inches
(to be determined in class)

Batting = Width of finished pieced top = 4" X Length of top + 4
(to be determined in class)
